1. Update on the Posts to be installed on the High Street Verge

The Contractors have ordered the post and are expecting delivery in 4-5 weeks. It is hoped that the installation will take place in the next 2-3 months.

2. Update on Parking Enforcement

The OCC Parking Manager has confirmed that any formal parking restrictions will be enforced by their enforcement contractor. There will be further contact with a member of the Parking Team to discuss options for residents parking.

3. Update on Electric Vehicle Charging

A member has contacted the OCC EV Charging Project Manager. It was reported that articles in newspaper about the lack of public charging points is preventing people from choosing the option of buying fully electric vehicles.

4. Options to improve parking and traffic flow to be put to the Parish Council

There was a discussions were a range of possible options were looked at from doing very little, through various combinations of yellow lines, to a full blown plan with residents parking in bays. A crossing in the High Street could be added to any of the options.

It was decided that definite options should be presented at the next meeting when they could be assessed by using an options appraisal method. A view was expressed that pre-covid levels of commuter parking have returned to the lower High Street.

It was reported that OCC have approved a 20mph speed limit for the Village.
