With the villages of Whitchurch and Whitchurch Hill taking their name from the Saxon for 'White Church', there has been a church on the site of St Mary the Virgin for over a thousand years.

Rebuilt on the foundations of an 11th Century Norman stone church in Victorian times, the Grade II* listed St Mary's we see today contains many features from previous eras.

The church of St John the Baptist was erected in 1883 as a chapel of ease. This second church in the parish, built to serve the growing village of Whitchurch Hill, was further developed in 1910 by Charles H. Palmer Esq. of the famous Reading biscuit makers Huntley & Palmer.
