## What's Happened Recently

The prolonged period of dry hot weather in the summer meant that the rate of growth was drastically reduced and grass turned brown. We therefore curtailed our activities and only began to resume them at the end of August. Thank you to everyone who's been helping out. Tasks have included:

- Weeding and watering, mowing paths and reviewing the mowing schedule at the Polish Garden
- Organising and participating in the official opening of the Polish Memorial Garden, which was attended by over 80 people
- Helping set up the Litter Bug Detectives Trail
- Cutting and shaping the hedge along the western edge of the Village Green car park and the beech hedge alongside Eastfield Lane
- Weeding and watering the flower beds
- Weeding the edges of the car park and cutting and shaping the holly hedge along the eastern side
