Priorities:

1. Speeding

1st Actions

- Meet with a consultant for advice on what is possible/options available
 - First from SODC
 - Second from a private company?
- Contact SODC re rejection of CASTROL funded sign to show lorries where to turn.
- Tidy vegetation around the village to improve visibility
 - Upper narrows
 - Soak-aways on the hill
- Online, email & Bulletin Survey to establish parking requirements in the village.
- Get more people to complete the training for speedwatch and ask again for support from local police.
- Message on website to encourage people to report lorries (and how to do it) and get people to support speedwatch
- Leaf Sweeping in Hardwick and whole village - chase up contractor that should do this.

- Pelican Crossing at the end of Eastfield lane by the Greyhound
- Street lights
- Pavements - All of them need redoing - Outside Carrie's house should be higher?
- Traffic will get worse without a plan to address it
 - More local housing
 - More delivery vans than a few years ago
- Parking - getting worse - people park for the Train and shops
 - Get Residents parking? Need more info

- Lorries - Need to report them and contest sign not getting permission
- Behavior of drivers in the narrows - how can we address it?
- Prune back vegetation by upper narrows to improve visibility
 - General vegetation in the village
 - soak-aways on the hill
- Speeding - speed watch - flashing lights? :) :(
- Online survey - who needs what parking - email and bulletin
- Follow up on village sign.
- There is a call to remove ALL parked cars to make crossing the road safer and driving through our village easier.
