

Green Team April and May 2024 Newsletter

The Green Team is a team of both core and ad hoc volunteers who help look after and maintain the green spaces in Whitchurch-on-Thames.

What's Happened Recently

- On Saturdays 13th April and 11th May there were working parties at the Maze to trim around the edges of the maze bricks and to cut the grass.
- At the Polish Memorial Garden, in April volunteers weeded the area around the site of the old church and cut back trees and shrubs. A working party in early May installed tree guards on the young apple trees, put up bat boxes and did some general tidying up and planting.
- On Saturdays 27th April and 25th May there were Village Green working parties. The work included tackling the brambles at the south end of the green, pulling up goosegrass and nettles, removing saplings and weeding the flower beds in the car park.
- In April, Lesley Maynerd led a working party at the MOWS flowerbeds at the entrance to Walliscote Drive. The beds and surrounding area were weeded and new plants were put in.

Work Coming Up

- There will be Maze working parties on 8th June and 13th July at 10am.
- The next Village Green working party is planned for the end of June.
