What's Happened Recently

The weather has continued to be variable, including an extended period of warm sunny days. The rate of growth has increased up noticeably. Thank you to everyone who's been helping out. Tasks have included:

- Maze working party
- Re-digging the flower bed at the Village Green car park, replanting it with geraniums, and recovering the ferns and cotoneaster
- Disposing of waste material (brambles and other unwanted plants) at the Green
- Clearing all hawthorn and brambles from the Jubilee beacon site
- Mowing grass, planting five heritage apple trees and digging and planting new bedding strips to either side of the chapel platform steps at the Polish Chapel Garden
