What's Happened Recently

We are still dealing with the luxuriant growth brought on by alternating rain and sunshine. A big thank you to everyone who's been helping out. Tasks have included:

- Working parties at the Polish Garden to clear ragwort and teasels/thistles
- Working party at the Maze to edge the grass and clear the area
- Trimming shrubs and clearing ivy from pavement on Manor Road (south side)
- Working party at the Village Green south end: continuing to remove invasive plants; cutting and digging out small sycamores and limes in spinneys
- Completing sanding and applying protective oil to the bench near the entrance to Walliscote House
