## What's Happened Recently

- There was a working party at the Polish Memorial Garden on 1st June to weed the gravelled area, prune some of the trees and shrubs and to water the plants in pots.
- A Maze working party was held on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> June.
- There was a Village Green working party on 24<sup>th</sup> June, which focussed on reducing the nettles, goosegrass and brambles around the mound by the practice nets.
- The recently planted yew trees in Manor Road are being regularly watered, but it seems that some of the trees are not thriving.
- Branches obscuring the 20 mph signs at the entrance to the village along Hardwick Road were cut back.
