## **What's Happened Recently**

The extreme changes of weather continued, but included an extended period of warm sunny days.. Thank you to everyone who's been helping out. Tasks have included:

- Mounting bird boxes and digging and planting a hornbeam hedge at the Polish Garden
- Cutting down a falling tree at the bottom of Muddy Lane
- Extracting hazel and privet, and cutting up and stacking hawthorn, at the beacon site
- Meeting and briefing potential contractors for resurfacing Muddy Lane
- Digging over the flower bed near the entrance to the Village Green car park
- Work party at the Village Green south end, digging out holly and removing brambles from here and along Eastfield Lane
