What's Happened Recently

- A Maze working party was held on Saturday 13th May.
- The area around the MOWS flower beds at the entrance to Walliscote Drive was weeded.
- We helped Jim Donahue to clear shrubs that were blocking the visibility of the 20mph sign at the entrance to the village from Whitchurch Hill.
- Comments were received by the Parish Council from a resident concerned that spring plant growth on the bank at the junction of Hardwick Road and the High Street was obscuring the view for traffic. The maintenance contractor trimmed the cow parsley and will mow again later. The Green Team guardian will also keep an eye on the area and cut back plants as necessary.
- There was no Village Green working party this month.
