What's Happened Recently

The weather has definitely shifted to cooler and rainier spells, with consequent changes to growth patterns. A big thank you to everyone who's been helping out. Tasks have included:

- Completing the refurbishment of the bench near the entrance of the driveway to Walliscote House. The bench now commemorates both the donor Stan Remington and his wife 'Pockets'. A small ceremony, organised by Leslie Maynerd, was held to mark this.
- Work party at the Maze to edge the grass and clear the central area
- Work party led by Martin Bengtzen and Frances Dixon, to weed the north verges of Manor Road, in preparation for mowing and for planting ferns, wood anemones, winter aconites, and rough chervil
- Work party at the Village Green south end, cutting the hedge along the western edge of the car park and facing north towards the cricket pavillion
- Reducing the height of sumach on the verge outside Eastfield House, as part of a plan to bring it under better control
